Admission Policy

Parents initially apply to the Head Teacher for a prospectus. This should be followed by a visit to the school. Once an application has been received the Head Teacher and Lead Tutor will arrange to assess each student. This may take place in either or both the student's current school and in their home.

To apply for a place at Snowflake School a student must have a diagnosis of an autistic spectrum disorder. It is desirable that the student also has, or be in the process of obtaining, a statement of special educational needs.

Snowflake School does not wish to discriminate between pupils and to this end believes that all pupils should be fully funded by their Local Authority.

The offer of a place is subject to:

- A suitable vacancy being available
- Snowflake School having the resources to meet the student's needs
- Appropriate funding being secured

An offer of a place will be made in writing and is valid for 3 months, after this time the place may be given to another student. Parents are asked to liaise closely with the Head Teacher during this time to ensure that all that is possible is done to ensure this does not occur.
