Dear Snowflake Families,  
RE: COVID -19 latest guidance,

Following the latest government advice to special schools (released 5.45pm on 31.12.20), I am writing to clarify with you the plans for the next two weeks in both Primary and Secondary sites.

#### Primary

- will be open from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January to pupils and January 4<sup>th</sup> to staff
- will be adhering to strict PPE and adult social distancing rules
- will only be in one site, the exception will be Tara and myself but we will keep distance when in both sites and wear both a mask and visor)
- will be closed to visitors
- will provide remote learning for those of you who have expressed a preference for this.

#### Secondary

- will be open for key worker pupils only, week 4<sup>th</sup> January
- will re-open to all pupils 11<sup>th</sup> January, as agreed with yourselves
- will be adhering to strict PPE and adult social distancing rules
- will be closed to visitors
- will provide remote learning for all pupils from 5<sup>th</sup> January
- will be testing all staff during week 4<sup>th</sup> January
- will be offering testing to pupils asap (starting with secondary)
- will be developing a recovery curriculum based on re building social interaction through communication and rebuilding an educational environment which is calm and safe.

I hope we are coming to the end of all this disruption and 2021 will be a safe, healthy and successful year for us all.
